SCOPE

The purpose of the International Symposium about Carniolan honeybees is to bring together scientists, researchers and queen breeders who are interested in the conservation of Carniolan honeybees *Apis mellifera carnica* and to establish collaboration between them.

The aim of this symposium is to:

- Present the issue of preserving the Carniolan honeybee in various countries.
- Establish collaboration between participating professionals in the field of Carniolan honeybee preservation and selection.
- Reach an agreement on consistent (morphological, ethological and genetic) parameters for the Carniolan honeybee (ecotypes).
- Establish an international group for the preservation of the Carniolan honeybee.
- Present good examples of preserving local subspecies of honeybees.

SYMPOSIUM AREAS

Each of the topic areas could be expanded, so this topic list is not exhaustive. Papers may address one or more of the listed topics:

- the status of the Carniolan honeybee across areas - countries in comparison with other bee subspecies,
- the criteria used to define the Carniolan honeybee,
- current activities in Carniolan honeybee preservation and selection,
- good practices of preserving local bee subspecies in individual regions.

LANGUAGE

The language of the symposium will be Slovenian and English. Simultaneous translation will be provided.



ABSTRACT FOR THE SYMPOSIUM

Authors should submit the abstract of their paper by e-mail to the address: **andreja.kandolf@czs.si**. The abstract text should be typed, be between 1000 and 2000 characters (including spaces) and formatted using the templates in Microsoft Word on the web site **www.kranjska-cebela.si**. Authors should send the abstract in English, checked for grammar and spelling, **by 15 December 2011**.

PAPERS FOR THE SYMPOSIUM

After the review process is complete, the corresponding author will be notified of the result by e-mail. It is recommended that authors prepare also full papers. These authors are required to follow the reviews in order to improve their paper before the final submission.
